TEDxBradenton speakers bring ideas worth sharing

(July 12, 2023) Bradenton, FL --- Event organizers shared three additional names of people who will be giving TED Talks at the upcoming TEDxBradenton conference happening Friday, September 29 at State College of Florida's Bradenton campus.

Each speaker will prepare a talk about an idea they have that relates to this year's theme "Writing the Future." Organizer Evelyn Almodovar explained that the theme was inspired by the idea that "we can all be creators of a better future for ourselves, our families, and our communities. The world is in constant change, but we are the authors of how we respond to that change."

An important feature of both the 2022 TEDxBradenton as well as this year's event will be the video recordings of the talks. Once the event is finished and the videos are edited and uploaded, TED reviews each to ensure adherence to guidelines about content and quality.

According to Almodóvar, approximately 40 percent of videos submitted from TEDx events around the world are approved and uploaded to the global TEDx YouTube channel. What was that rate for Bradenton? "Fortunately," Almodóvar answered, "all of the videos submitted by TEDxBradenton in 2022 were accepted and published."

Publishing these videos on the TEDx YouTube channel, with its 38.5 million subscribers, matters because TED is fundamentally a knowledge sharing platform that is available for free across the world any time.

The videos generated from TEDxBradenton "live on" well after the event and cross peoples' paths who are interested in our region and the topic of the talk. Event organizers pointed to the reach of their 2022 videos: "These talks have collectively garnered more than 16,000 views, a number that grows by 10% every two months as more people discover TEDxBradenton."
